## 1. Overview

- 1.1 The School's uniform is very distinctive and students wearing it are representing the School. It is very important therefore that whilst in uniform the students do not portray themselves and the School in a negative light, even outside of School premises and hours
- 1.2 The Schools' uniform has been designed to adhere to Islamic codes of modesty, and the students are expected to uphold this in the way in which they are dressed
- 1.3 A School uniform enhances equality amongst students. Expensive and luxury items are not permitted as part of the uniform. Female students must not wear face veils or abayas. Headscarves must not be adorned or flamboyant

## 2. Uniform Requirements

All items are available for purchase from John Lewis.

### 2.1 For boys:

- Dark grey trousers
- Brondesbury College striped tie
- Grey V neck jumper with School's logo
- Teal blazer with School's logo
- White long/short sleeved shirt
- Black or grey School coat (no motifs or labelled markings to be visible)
- Black School bag
- Black or dark grey socks
- Plain black shoes

### 2.2 Physical Education Kit:

- Short sleeved polo shirt in house colour with School's logo
- Black tracksuit top with School's logo
- Black tracksuit bottoms

### 2.3 For girls:

- Long grey skirt
- Grey cardigan with School's logo
- Teal blazer with School's logo
- White long sleeved shirt
- Black or grey School coat (no motifs or labelled markings to be visible)
- Black School bag
- Black or dark grey socks or opaque tights
- White square headscarf
- White under-scarf piece (if needed)
- Plain black shoes with no heels

### 2.4 Physical Education Kit:

- Long sleeved polo shirt in house colour with School's logo

- Black tracksuit top with School's logo
- Black tracksuit bottoms

After PE students must change back into correct School uniform before leaving the School premises.

### **3. Non-School Uniform Day Restrictions**

3.1 On non-uniform days, students will adhere to principles set out by the School to ensure students are modestly dressed. The following details the basic rules which may be added to by the Head Teacher:

- No jeans allowed
- No shirts with a slogan, logo, initials or forms of words which are offensive
- Trousers should be reasonably loose fitting and not tight
- Loose and long tops that cover up to the knees
- No 'hoodie' sweatshirts allowed
- No leather/leather-look jackets allowed
- Clothing worn should be smart, clean and respectable

3.2 Any student who comes to School dressed in incorrect uniform, or whose uniform is worn in an inappropriate manner, will immediately be sent home to change

### **4. Hairstyles and Colouring**

4.1 Parents should be aware that we do not permit extremes of fashion in students' hairstyles or dress

4.2 Added hair colour is not permitted and patterns cut into hair or eyebrows are not acceptable

4.3 Extreme hairstyles, resembling 'recent fashion' is not acceptable.

4.4 For boys all hairstyles should be of one level e.g. not shorter around the back and longer at the top

4.5 Students who have shoulder length hair, or longer, may be required to tie it back for health and safety reasons and/or if it obscures the face

### **5. Jewellery and Valuables**

5.1 Jewellery should be limited to a watch

5.2 Watches should be removed for practical lessons or any lesson where they may pose a danger

5.3 The School cannot accept any responsibility for the loss of valuables

### **6. Duties of a Teacher with respect to School Uniform**

6.1 Form Tutors will check that the correct uniform is being worn during morning and afternoon registration sessions

- 6.2 Each subject teacher will also check and deal with any breaches to this policy in accordance with the Schools 'Behaviour & Reward Policy'
- 6.3 These checks will be brief and should be a normal and expected part of the start of any lessons
